WEEKLY RECAP

December 25, 2017 through December 31, 2017

DWLS, Warrant and OWI Arrests

Between December 25 and December 31st, FDPS personnel made four (4) misdemeanor driver license related or warrant arrests and one (1) operating while intoxicated arrest as a result of conducting proactive traffic enforcement.

Open Alcohol in a Motor Vehicle

On December 26, 2017 at approximately 8:11 PM an Officer stopped a vehicle in the area of Grand River and Gill for tuning without signaling. As a result of the traffic stop, the 24 year old male passenger was cited for possessing open alcohol in a motor vehicle and was found to have valid warrants for his arrest.

Assist Farmington Hills Police/Fire

On December 27, 2017 at approximately 11:21 PM a Sergeant observed a vehicle on the side of the road in the area of M5 and Drake in Farmington Hills. The Sergeant observed a male standing on the side of the road, holding an infant upside down. The Sergeant determined that the 18 month old was breathing, but having a medical emergency; Farmington Hills Fire Department was requested priority 1. The Sergeant continued to assist until FHFD transported the infant to the hospital.

False ID to Police

On December 29, 2017 at approximately 11:29 PM Officers responded to a Farmington business for a report of a patron that appeared to be acting "odd". Officers eventually located the 54 year old male subject who provided Officers with a false name while continuing to act "oddly", muttering and incoherently speaking. The Officers were able to identify the subject using a mobile fingerprint device, and learned that the subject had a mental order and valid warrants for his arrest. The subject was arrested, issued a citation and held in the Farmington jail.

Recovered Stolen Vehicle

On December 30, 2017 an Officer was patrolling a Farmington Apartment complex and located a vehicle that was reported stolen out of Detroit. The Officer made contact with the 24 year old Farmington Apartment resident who was arrested on valid warrants out of Farmington Hills. The vehicle was impounded at the request of the Detroit Police Department.

Possession of Marijuana

On December 31, 2017 at approximately 1:23 AM an Officer stopped a vehicle in the area of Grand Rover and Power for emitting white light to the rear of the vehicle. As a result of the traffic stop, the 19 year old male driver was arrested for possessing suspected marijuana that the Officer observed while speaking to the driver during the traffic stop.

Breaking and Entering (Building)

On December 31, 2017 Officers responded to, and investigated the breaking and entering of two Farmington businesses. In both cases, the glass door was broken out and the cash drawer attacked and cash taken.

In one case the suspect is described to be a medium build male, wearing a dark knit cap, dark baggie hooded jacket, grayish (light) hooded sweatshirt, and baggie pants. The suspect also appears to be wearing a winter ski-mask.

In the second case the suspect is described to be a white male, thin build, wearing jeans, a dark colored jacket, gray scarf, winter hat, gloves and his face is exposed.

Farmington Hills Police is investigating two B&E's with the same modus operandi and similar suspect descriptions.
