### SUMMARY OF NOTABLE INCIDENTS

#### Fraud

On November 26, 2018 at approximately 3:06 pm a Farmington resident reported that an unknown male subject called them on November 23<sup>rd</sup> and de-fraud them out of two hundred dollars. The resident stated that the caller had an accent and pretended to be from Amazon customer service. The caller instructed the resident to purchase Google Play gift cards at Walgreens and then provide them with the card numbers and security codes. The resident followed the callers instructions and turned over two hundred dollars before realizing they had be victimized. The check of phone number revealed a VOIP that are often untraceable or terminate overseas.

#### Suspicious Circumstance

On November 29, 2018 at approximately 8:33 am an officer responded to a request for police assistance on Slocum after a Farmington resident reported a confrontation with an unknown male subject that was walking a Pitbull type dog. The resident described the male to be white and possibly in his 50's. The resident observed the dog get away from the male subject and run across the street. The resident stated that they stepped outside to tell the male to keep control of the dog. The subject responded by flipping the middle finger and yelling expletives. The area was checked, but the male subject was not located.

#### Larceny – Recovered Stolen Items

On November 30, 2018 at approximately 3:54 pm officers responded to a residence on Gill Road for a report of packages stolen from the front porch of the residence. The subject responsible for the theft was described to be a teenage male, tall, average build, last seen wearing a green coat w/hood, black pants, had a bloody bandage on his left hand and was carrying an Adidas backpack. The subject was chased into a nearby garage where he was confronted and then departed on foot in the direction of Grand River Ave. The items were recovered and a NIXLE alert sent to the community warning of "Porch Pirates."

### **Larceny – Recovered Stolen Item**

On November 30, 2018 at approximately 8:09 pm officers responded to a Farmington restaurant for a report of a stolen cell phone. Officers learned that at approximately 4:54 pm the victim placed a cell phone on the counter near the cash register, departed and later realized that the phone was left behind. Officers reviewed the surveillance video and were able to clearly see a white male subject take the phone from the counter and eventually leave. A suspect was developed when the subject's partner paid with a credit card. Officers attempted to make contact, but were eventually called back when the suspect returned the cell phone. The case is still open pending an interview with the subject responsible for the theft.
