### SUMMARY OF NOTABLE INCIDENTS

#### Fraud

On 08/20/2024 officers were dispatched to the 23000 block of Farmington Rd for a reported fraud – illegal use of credit cards. Officers met with the victim, a 30-year-old male who reported that he received an alert on his phone about his credit card being used at a local store. Officers were able to obtain video of the transaction and discovered that two suspects, one male and one female approximately 30 years old were seen swiping multiple credit cards to pay for their groceries. Officers were also able to identify the suspect vehicle. The case has been forwarded to the detective bureau for investigation.

#### Fraud

On 08/22/2024 officers were dispatched to the 23000 block of Farmington Rd. for a reported fraud. Officers met with the victim, a 71-year-old female who reported that she received information from her bank about an unapproved withdraw from one of her bank accounts. The suspect used a passport with the victim’s identification to withdraw the funds. The bank conducted an internal investigation, and the victim was refunded her money.
